Whereas, the MIT Campus Police were proactive in engaging students for input on their new poster campaign; and

Whereas, the MIT Campus Police are seeking formal approval for the posters by the Graduate Student Council; and

Whereas, the new posters are part of an ongoing campaign by the MIT Campus Police to become more student-friendly; and

Whereas, concerns have been expressed that the current design includes gender-specific characters associated with the issues addressed in the posters:
