NEW YORK (AP) -- Stocks edged higher Tuesday following upbeat signs of economic improvement overseas and continued takeover activity.

Overseas markets rose following upbeat economic reports in Asia and growing hopes European leaders will complete a bailout for debt-burdened Greece.

GM names board member Girsky vice chairman

DETROIT (AP) -- General Motors Co.'s February sales rose 11.5 percent thanks to new models and pent-up demand from fleet buyers, but it was unclear how much the Detroit automaker benefited from Toyota's safety woes.

GM on Tuesday said sales of its Buick, Chevrolet, Cadillac and GMC brands climbed 32 percent. GM plans to keep those four brands and is phasing out Pontiac, Saturn and Hummer. It has sold Saab.

Letter of Credit: A form of guarantee of payment issued by a bank used to guarantee the payment of [interest](#) and repayment of [principal](#) on bond issues.

On the run: The most recently issued (and, therefore, typically the most [liquid](#)) [government bond](#) in a particular maturity range.

Swap rate: The difference between [spot](#) and [forward rates](#) expressed in points, e.g., \$0.0001 per pound sterling.
