

## 40 U.A.S. 4.1 Bill to create LaTeX bill class for the UA Senate

Whereas UA Bills should look pretty; and

Whereas LATEX is an excellent language for creating pretty documents, but has an unfortunately steep learning curve, making it difficult for the layman to create a nonstandard document without assistance from an expert;
