CHANGES AND ENHANCEMENTS:

This release of the RoamAbout Windows drivers includes the following new features:

- There are different drivers for the Microsoft Windows operating systems:
 - The NDIS 3 Miniport Driver for Windows 95.
 - The NDIS 4 Miniport Driver for Windows NT.
 - The NDIS 5 Miniport Driver for Windows 98, 2000 and Millennium.
- The client stations can be configured for Peer-to-Peer Group communication. This mode is compliant with the IEEE 802.11 IBSS (Independent Basic Service Set) operation. The previous non-IEEE-compliant "Ad-Hoc Demo Mode" can no longer be selected through the user interface.
- This version includes new user interfaces to provide easier configuration of the client stations.
 - A new Client Utility icon located in the System Tray. This new icon launches the Client Utility.
 - The user interface of the Windows Card Settings function is improved:
 - The configuration profiles are now qualified for the type of network:
 - Peer-to-Peer Group (IBSS; network without AP)

This causes further configuration screens (tabs) to be adapted accordingly.

- An empty Wireless Network Name, for connection to an Access Point is treated the same as "ANY"; i.e. connect to any network.
- Check the web site for WSU updates.

KNOWN RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITATIONS:

- If you are upgrading an existing driver, you must also upgrade the Client Utility.
- If you are using encryption with RoamAbout Access Points that have firmware 5.01 or later, make sure that the station's secondary firmware of the RoamAbout PC card is V4.52 or later. Refer to the *RoamAbout Wireless Networking Guide* for the procedure to check firmware revisions. A Workstation Update (WSU) tool is available from the RoamAbout Wireless web site: <http://www.enterasys.com/wireless>, to upgrade the station firmware.

Any other problems than those listed above should be reported to our Technical Support Staff.
